Africa

Kenya AA Masai

Jamaican Blue Mountain

“Wallenford estate” from the blue mountain district of Jamaica, mild and aromatic with hints of chocolate.

Costa Rica offers a high grown strictly hard bean from the Pacific slopes. It is hearty, smooth and enticing

Brazilian Santos Vintage

mellow brew with hints of cocoa and a smooth after taste of delicate mild nuts

Guatemala Las Nubes

sweet, spice and chocolate toned fruitiness, this light bodied coffee rivals the great washed coffee of Ethiopia

The Legend of Teas

Legend has it that, one day in 2737 B.C. the Chinese Emperor Shen Nung was boiling drinking water over an open fire, when some leaves from a nearby camellia sinensis plant fell into the pot.

The emperor drank the mixture and declared that it gave one “vigor of body, contentment of mind and determination of purpose.”

Many tea drinkers find the beverage soothing and folk medicine has long valued it as a remedy for sore throats and unsettled stomach so much so that today it is said to reduce the risk of serious illnesses including atherosclerosis and some cancers

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International Teas

Sri Lanka

the teas produced in each region have their own individual characteristic flavour, aroma and colour. High grown teas, from heights of between 3500 and 7500 feet are very best that Sri Lanka produces with a beautiful golden liquor and an intense powerful flavour.

Nuwara Eliya

literally meaning near the clouds, this high grown Sri Lankan tea has a wonderful aroma and sometimes competes with Darjeeling teas

Dimbula

most famous of the Ceylon teas, this high grown tea has a characteristic flavour and sweet aroma

Uva

an all-time tea, found almost in every corner of the world

De-caffeinated

delicate, mellow and aromatic caffeine free tea

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China

first to start drinking teas, the Chinese perfected this tradition over five centuries. Most noted for its green unfermented teas which have very delicate flavours with proven health benefits.

Monkey Pick Tea

nurtured at Anhue province in China, specially trained monkeys paw-pick these leaves from unpruned 15 to 20 feet high bushes. this tea yields a pale golden brew with earthy flavours.

Dragonwell Green

sharp needle like leaves duly flattened in a special extruder like machine, gives a heavy bodied green tea.

Jade Green

natural half rolled leaf which yields dark green brew instead of the usual yellowish green brew.

Yunan Red

long wiry light brown clonal leaves give a very unique smoky brown colour and flavor: it is mostly taken without even a drop of milk

Chinese Pearls

complete two leaves and one bud rolled together in the category of semi fermented and among the most popular Oriental teas

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Taiwan

cultivated in the high mountains of this island and are identified with perfection in both green and red.

Formosa Green

a lightly oxidized tea that gives a delicate oolong brew milk a lingering after taste

Formosa Oolong

semi fermented tea, the only leaf which has the two leaves and bud almost intact in the final stage of tea manufacture

Middle Eastern

Egyptian Chamomile

a special blend of the finest chamomile flowers given birth to a brew that soothes with every sip and warm, earthy notes that bring you calm after a long day

Moroccan Mint

a rich blend of handpicked mint and the choicest of tea leaves gives you a brew that's both sweet and strong. one that takes you to morocco with every refreshing sip

Darjeeling

Darjeeling White

Castleton Rare Muscatel

exotic brew from the Goodricks’ estate gives a sweet aroma with mild taste.

Autumn Flush

though the least famous of the Darjeeling flushes, some recent modifications have yielded a very special combination of taste and flavour which provide a welcome change.

Makaibari Golden Tips

the makaibari is world renowned for flowery notes, full of aromas with just the right amount of briskness.

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Assam

from the land of the Brahmaputra river, these teas are often full bodied, with a bright liquor. a favorite among those who prefer a strong tea.

Assam White

provides more taste than the usual hot water variety with all virtues of antioxidant leaves, a recent innovation with high acceptance.

Langlai Organic Tea

perfect rich bodied tea which goes very well with milk.

Manglam Golden Tips

grown on the high slopes of Assam, its golden-brown tips release a delicate malty taste and sweet aromatic brew with rich body.
